NEO-MOORISH STYLE IN THE ARCHITECTURE OF THE TBILISI OPERA AND BALLET THEATER The author examines the history of the construction and interior decoration of the Neo-Moorish theater in Tiflis. The first building, built in Tiflis under the Caucasian governor M. S. Vorontsov, represented an early and rare example of a theater, the interiors of which were decorated in the Neo-Moorish style by the artist Prince G. G. Gagarin. After the loss of the first building, the new «Tiflis state theater» was built according to the project of the St. Petersburg architect V. A. Schreter. Despite several transformations during the 20th century, the architectural appearance of the Tbilisi Opera and Ballet Theater with it's interiors in the Oriental style represents a single stylistic ensemble and a rare example of theater architecture in the Neo-Moorish style of the second half of the 19th century.

ILIA ZDANÉVICH-ILIAZD AND HIS BOOK THE POETRY OF UNKNOWN WORDS: FOR THE 70-TH ANNIVERSARY EDITION

This article, besides the 60-year long (1912-1975) creative journey, looks at the post-war period of Ilia Zdanevich's (1896-1975) work, related to his publishing activity in genre of livre d'artiste. A bright avant-gardist himself, who in his youth had participated in one of the most radical futuristic group, «41°" (Tiflis), a poet, a specialist in Medieval Architecture and newest painting styles, Iliazd (the pceudonim Zdanevich adopted in 1922 in Paris) was able to surround himself with the artists who otherwise never came together due to creative confrontation. This is how the The Poetry of Unknown Words (Poésie de mots inconnus) was created. In this book, the abstruse poetry coexists with predominantly abstract art. Its significance is way larger than just the heated discussion that ensued in post-war France around the new literary movement of lettrism, announced by I. Izou. In this article, we have highlighted the stages of development of both Iliazd's work and livre d'artiste art in Russia. The research allows us to revisit this extraordinary master who greatly assisted the development of such a young - yet ancient - art form as an «artist's book».

A $\bar{\text{NEW}}$ INTERPRETATION OF THE POLICY OF THE METROPOLIS DURING THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION

The author examines a new monograph by L. V. Sidorenko, a specialist in the history of Great Britain during «the long eighteenth century», which was devoted to the problems of ideological and political struggle in the metropolis during its confrontation with the North American colonies within the American Revolution. The author of the review carries out a detailed analysis of the three chapters of the monograph from a thematic and problematic point of view, demonstrating strong and weak sides of the analyzed book. The review notes that the second chapter, which reveals the declared confrontation between the British counterrevolution and the American Revolution through the prism of complex processes of political and constitutional confrontation between various socio-political forces of the metropolis during the US War of Independence, turned out to be the most complete and high-quality in the monograph. Other advantages of the book are the analysis of the confrontation between two types of electoral systems (virtual representation in the metropolis and actual in the colonies), as well as the clarification of the role of the British monarch George III, tainted by the Declaration of Independence, represented by L. V. Sidorenko more as a defender of parliamentary interests than a convinced tyrant.

«IT'S A PITY, BECAUSE IT WAS A GREAT THOUGHT»: THE EVOLUTION OF THE PLANS OF THE RUSSIAN MILITARY COMMAND AT THE FIRST STAGE OF THE CRIMEAN WAR

The author examines the evolution of Russian military plans in the initial period of the Crimean War. The sources used are the handwritten notes of Nicholas I and the materials of the emperor's correspondence with Field Marshal I. F. Paskevich. Nicholas I tried to avoid a major war with the European powers, preferring either to quickly defeat Turkey by landing troops on the Bosphorus, or to put pressure on it by occupying the Danube principalities. The landing operation corresponded to the capabilities of the Black Sea Fleet, provided that England and France did not interfere. The rapid development of the diplomatic crisis, the isolation of Russia, the hostile position of not only England and France, but also Austria destroyed hopes for a quick success. The temporary occupation of the Danube principalities provoked the intervention of the powers. The Russian command feared an attack by the Austrian army in the west and southwest, considering the Crimean Theater secondary. Russia could not win the war with all the great powers, and Paskevich tried to delay the time and reduce possible losses to a minimum.
