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RARE 19TH CENTURY COSTUME HISTORY PUBLICATION FROM THE FUNDS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE RUSSIAN ACADEMY OF SCIENCE LIBRARY AT THE MUSEUM OF ANTHROPOLOGY AND ETHNOGRAPHY (KUNSTKAMERA)

The article considers the ongoing German publication «Blätter für Kostümkunde: Historische und Volks-Trachten»(1870-1890s),13 issues (156 lithographs) of which are stored in the Russian Academy of Science Library Department at the Museum of Anthropologyand Ethnography named after Peter the Great (Kunstkamera). It was revealed that based on the patterns of their predecessors, artistsunder the guidance of art and costume researcher A. von Heyden reconstructed types of different eras, countries and nationalities ofEurope and Asia from the 11th to the first third of the 19th century. The names of the artists who worked on the images are called.The methodology of their work, based on the study of pictorial sources, acquaintance with museum collections and drawings fromnature, is investigated. It tells about the great importance of the texts of the «Sheets», containing descriptions of costumes, namesof clothing items and references to sources. As a bibliographic appendix, a list of illustrations and texts is proposed, accompaniedby indexes of artists and authors of comments.

The article is devoted to the main theme in the work of Oskar Kokoschka - the dehumanization of the role of the body in order to give it a sexualized character. In the twentieth century, there was a revision of the methods of interpreting the subjectivization of the body. The role of the body in the work of Oskar Kokoschka defines the constant of the Austrian line of expressionism, which consists in the perceptual indulgence of the inner hysteria. The author gives a description of the doll and the sexualized functions given to it, expressed through fetishistic paraphilia and alterago of the artist. The topic reveals the need for contextual interpretation with the author in the discourse of his time, the role of an active gesture of a woman in the male world and selfidentification of a person, placing sexualized images in different contexts. The doll is a marking object of depersonalized methods of sexualizing the expression of the artist's personality, where for Oskar Kokoschka it manifested itself in the replacement of the living with an eroticized body of artificial flesh. The author also cites the play «The Murderer, the Hope of Women» (1907) as an example of interpersonal conflicts in a marginal society, raising the question of a new kind of simulation of reality, where the role of the body becomes an illustrative framework in the subjective interpretation of social alienation. In that way artist broadcast sexual aberration as a theatrical gesture.

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RITUAL TRADITION AND ORAL STORIES OF THE SOUTHERN URAL AS AN ETHNOGRAPHIC SOURCE (ETHNO-REALITY «LAPTI»)

In the article, on the material of oral stories, the ethno-reality «bast shoes» is presented in its connection with the everyday and ritual culture of the population of the mining area of the Southern Ural. The author comes to the conclusion that until the middle of the20th century, interest in bast shoes was supported by the availability of wood material, its practical properties, and the possibility of home-made shoes. In ritual culture, the functioning of bast shoes continues to perform a symbolic function associated with the basic archaic opposition «old-new», «friend-foe», «clean-unclean»; and the preservation of common Slavic traditions in the new territories. The article supplements ethnographic studies with new folklore materials, actualizes the significance of local descriptions in studies of traditional culture in different areas.

THE AUTHOR AND THE HERO AS «NON-STATIONARY STATES»: ABOUT THE FEATURES OF THE SUBJECTIVE SPHERE OF M. BULGAKOV'S NOVEL «THE MASTER AND MARGARITA»

The article analyzes the specifics of the subjective organization of M. Bulgakov's novel «The Master and Margarita», that is, a system of dialogically correlated with each other in the narrative «subjects of speech» and «subjects of consciousness» (B. Korman). The principles of interaction of the horizons of the «primary author» and narrators, as subjects of image and speech close to him, with the horizons of the novel's heroes, insufficiently studied in Russian literary studies, are revealed. The relevance of the undertaken research lies in the fact that it allowed, based on the ideas of M. Bakhtin, to discover the author and the hero not as ready and completed functional units in the work, but as «intermittent, non-stationary states» (S. Broitman), characteristic of the non-classical type of artistry, thereby supplementing the existing interpretations of the narrative structure of M. Bulgakov's novel.

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«FEMALE PERSONS» IN «THE NOBLE PEDIGREE BOOK ST. PETERSBURG PROVINCE (1789-1791)»

«The Noble Genealogy Book of the St. Petersburg Province» is a unique historical source on the history of the Russian nobility. It is stored in a single copy in the Central State Historical Archive of St. Petersburg (TsGIA St. Petersburg. Fund 536. Inventory 1. Case 1a). The document is considered to be the first noble genealogy book that has been preserved in St. Petersburg and the capital province since the award in 1785 by Catherine II Alekseevna «Charters for the rights, liberties and advantages of the noble Russian nobility»; covers the first three years of introducing noble families (1789-1791). The genealogical book records the process of completing the legal registration of the nobility in the Russian Empire and is the historical source that secured the privileges of the nobility of the capital and the metropolitan province. Analysis of the document makes it possible to establish the status of members of the noble corporation who were in the military, civil service or retired. The article is devoted to the *«female persons» of the nobility, whose names are found on the pages of the genealogical book.* Information about 22 women included in the document was analyzed in such a way as to fully illuminate the data contained in the historical source. In addition, a number of questions were raised and studied regarding the dowry of noblewomen, marriage union, ownership of real estate (land fund and serf souls), their position in society, the estate status of those whom hereditary nobles married, etc. Also, the article considered separate biographies of the noblewomen of the St. Petersburg province, representatives of both titled noble families and lesser-known hereditary noblewomen.

This author examines the state of administration of the St. Petersburg Diocese on the eve and during the First World War. The changes of the diocesan government related to the replacement of metropolitan chairs are presented: Vladimir (Bogoyavlensky) from November 23, 1912 to November 23, 1915; Pitirim (Oknov), from November 23, 1915 to March 6, 1917; Veniamin (Kazantsev) from April 1917 to August 12, 1922. Legislative decisions are being studied. The situation of the St. Petersburg province in wartime is determined, the facts of extensive charitable activities in the parishes of the diocese for the needs of the front (opening of infirmaries for the wounded, assistance to the families of soldiers, fundraising, etc.) are presented, the consequences of opening new parishes, the establishment of parish societies, guardianship and fraternities are studied.
